

Arena Rider Membership Terms & Conditions

DEFINITION AND PURCHASER PRIVILEGES

Arena Rider Membership may be purchased at any time during the year and is an annual pass which entitles the holder to the following for one (1) year from the date of purchase:

- Membership to the Nechako Valley Exhibition Society
- Society meeting attendance and voting privileges of the Society
- Indoor and outdoor riding facilities including arenas, roadways, and trails
- Use of arena apparatus (barrels, jumps, poles, etc.)
- Free attendance to seasonal time slots

Other Membership types include General membership and Recreation membership. Please inquire at the Office for more details.

ARENA RIDER MEMBERSHIP TYPES & FEES

Membership may be purchased with a 5-month payment plan or in full.

Both options grant the holder a ONE YEAR pass. Any payment plan in arrears will render the pass holder ineligible for a membership renewal payment plan the following year; membership renewal will have to be paid in full.

DROP-IN	\$20 per day
Drop-ins are pay-per-day fee for guests. They do not grant the purchaser membership to the Society nor voting privileges. Drop-in fees may not be applied to a future membership purchase. Arena Rider members are responsible for collecting and submitting fees for their guests.	
5 YEARS AND UNDER	Free
Child must be accompanied by a parent/guardian who has paid a drop-in or membership fee	
YOUTH (6-18 years old)	\$168.00
Individual Youth membership: \$160.00 + GST	
- Payment Plan: \$170.00 + GST \$35.70/month	
Additional Youth in Same Family – \$100.00 + GST (\$105.00)	
- Payment Plan: \$110.00 + GST \$23.10/month	
ADULT (19 years and older)	\$357.00
Individual Adult membership \$340.00 + GST	
- Payment Plan: \$350.00 + GST \$73.50/month	
FAMILY	\$567.00
Two adults OR two adults plus one or more children 6-18 years: \$540.00 + GST	
- Payment Plan: \$550.00 + GST \$115.50/month	

MEMBER EXPECTATIONS

- All drop-in and member riders must adhere to the posted seasonal schedule
- Fees must be paid prior to riding
- All riders must clean up after their horses
- No cattle, barrels, poles, or other equipment to be used during Open Riding times
- All equipment must be put away after use
- Annual membership is a requirement for boarding; see Office to arrange short or long-term horse boarding
- Please be respectful of other members and Nechako Valley Exhibition Society staff and directors
- Please help to ensure that facilities are left clean and tidy after use
- Please park vehicles and horse trailers so as not to restrict access to entrances and to maximize parking for other facility users
- Please report faulty equipment, damaged pens and stalls, or other damage to the grounds to the Office
- Please ensure that lobby, washroom, and arena lights are turned off after use
- Dogs are not permitted in the arena unless participating in an organized canine event
- Dogs on the Grounds must always be under control and on a leash

SAFETY RULES

- Protective head gear is recommended for riders of all ages
- Youth riders (aged 18 and under) must wear a helmet while riding
- Lights in the indoor arena must be turned on after dusk
- Unsafe or reckless riding behaviour is strictly prohibited
- All livestock and horses must be kept under control
- All animals left at the facility must be housed in secured pens/stalls
- All animals must be treated humanely
- The maximum speed limit on roadways is 20 km/h
- Posted signage regarding general and riding safety and arena usage must be obeyed

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

- Horse Council BC membership is required for all members and drop-in riders. Staff reserve the right to request proof of membership at any time.
- **Drop-in and members must fill out an adult or youth liability waiver once per calendar year to retain riding privileges. Membership will only be granted to applications including a completed liability waiver for each person.**

COVID-19

COVID-19 Rules and Regulations may be subject to change as guidance from the Public Health Authority evolves. Staff, volunteers, and public must adhere to posted signage within the Facility. At the time of writing, members and drop-ins are required to wear masks in indoor areas except while riding or exercising horses. Please obey capacity, mask, and physical distancing requirements. Inquiries or concerns may be directed to the Office. Aggression, verbal abuse or harassment towards staff, volunteers or public facility users will not be tolerated and will result in suspension or expulsion of privileges at the arena.
